FALLINGWATER is the name of a house built over a waterfall in Southwest, PA. It is a house that doesn't appear to stand on solid ground but instead stretches out over a 30' waterfall. It captured everyone's attention when it was on the cover of Time magazine in 1938. It instantly became famous and today it is a National Historic Landmark.
