

In 2016-17, pianist **LYDIA ARTYMIW** celebrates her 28th year as Distinguished McKnight Professor of Piano at the University of Minnesota. Artymiw also received the U of M's 2015 "Excellence in Graduate Teaching Award," the "Dean's Medal for Outstanding Professor" in 2000, and Thursday Musical of Minnesota's "2016 Teacher of the Year" award. In 2015, Artymiw was on the jury for the first Van Cliburn Junior International Piano Competition in Fort Worth, TX, as well as on the juries for

ten piano concerto competitions at the Juilliard and Manhattan Schools in New York. She was a guest piano teacher at Juilliard in October 2015 and presented her first master class at Juilliard in March 2016. PRESENTATIONS BY...MARVIN BLICKENSTAFF and CARL CRANMER



MARVIN BLICKENSTAFF is known among piano teachers throughout the country for his teaching, lecturing, performing, and publishing. He has presented workshops for piano teachers throughout the USA, and appears frequently as soloist and lecturer at state conventions of music teachers and at the national convention of the Music Teachers National Association. For the past eleven years he has been on the faculty of International Workshops where he has performed and lectured

in Canada, Austria, Scotland, Norway, France, and Switzerland. In 1992 he was honored by the Indiana Music Teachers Association with the citation of "Teacher of the Year." In 1995 The Registered Piano Teachers of New Zealand sponsored him in concert and a 15-lecture tour of that country. He currently serves as Board President of the Frances Clark Center for Keyboard Pedagogy. Read more on the PMTA website.



CARL CRANMER was born and studied in West Chester Pennsylvania and made his debut with the Philadelphia Orchestra at the age of nine. Since then, in addition to solo recitals in Europe, Asia, and North America, he has performed in concert with the Royal Philharmonic of England, the Gulbenkian Orquesta of Portugal, the Juilliard Orchestra and several other orchestras on the Eastern Seaboard. In addition to his study in conservatories of music in the United States, he also studied at the Sommerakademie at the Mozarteum, in Salzburg, Austria under full scholarship, where he was under the tutelage of

distinguished teachers Karlheinz Kammerling, Jacob Lateiner, and Hans Graf. Read more on the PMTA website.

KEYNOTE SPEAKER...SENATOR ANDY DINNIMAN



SENATOR ANDY DINNIMAN was born in New Haven,
Connecticut. He received his BA from the University of
Connecticut in 1966, and his MA from the University of Maryland
in 1969. He also holds an Ed.D from Pennsylvania State
University. Dinniman's first elected position was as a member of
Downingtown school district's board of school directors. He was
first elected to this position in 1975, and held the post until 1979.
In 1979, Dinniman was elected chairman of the Chester County
Democratic Committee, a position he held until 1985. Dinniman
later served as Chester County commissioner for three terms,

COMMISSIONED COMPOSER...NANCY GALBRAITH



NANCY GALBRAITH (b.1951) resides in Pittsburgh,
Pennsylvania, USA, where she is Professor of Composition at
Carnegie Mellon University. In a career that spans three decades,
her music has earned praise for its rich harmonic texture,
rhythmic vitality, emotional and spiritual depth, and wide range of
expression. Her works have been directed by some of the world's
finest conductors, including Gennady Rozhdestvensky, Mariss
Jansons, Keith Lockhart, Sidney Harth, Samuel Jones, and
Robert Page. Her compositions are featured on numerous
recordings, including six anthologies. With major contributions to

the repertoires of symphony orchestras, concert choirs, wind ensembles, chamber ensembles, electroacoustic ensembles, and soloists, Galbraith plays a leading role in defining the sound of contemporary classical music.
