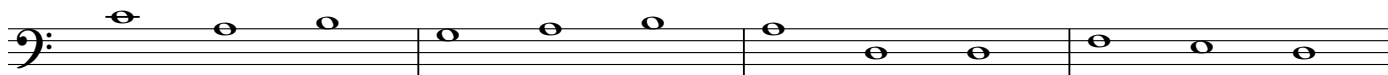

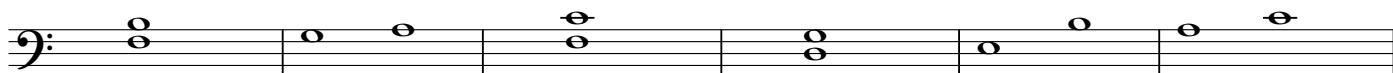

3. Draw *one rhythmic value* that completes each math problem below.

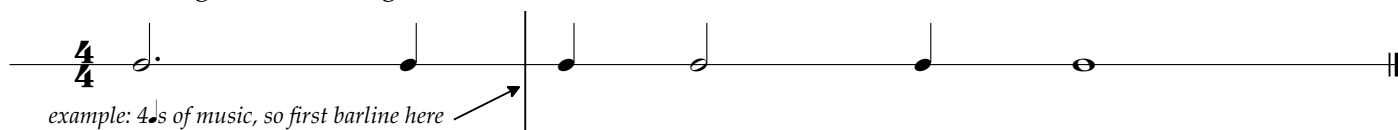
example: $\text{quarter note} + \text{quarter note} = \text{half note}$ $\text{half note} - \text{quarter note} = \text{quarter note}$
