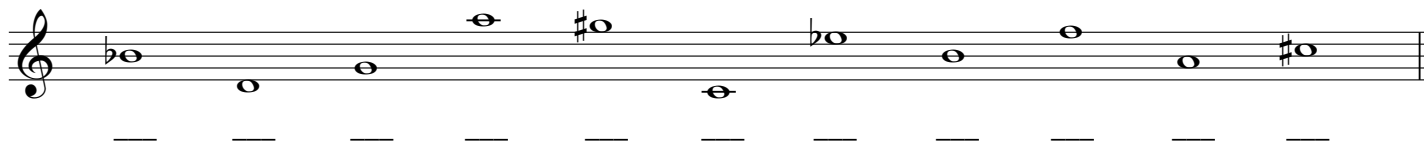
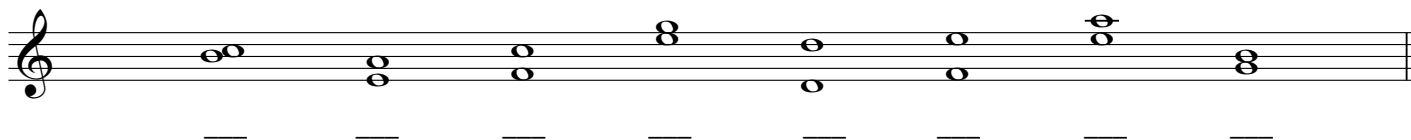

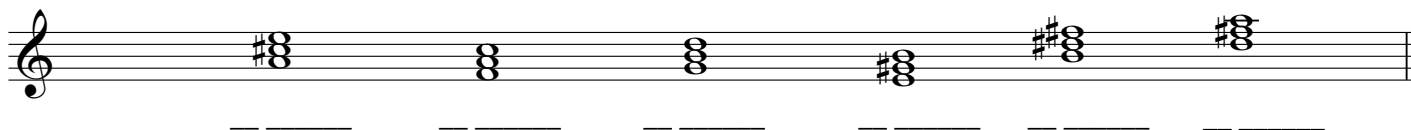
1. Write the *pitch letter name* under each note below. Be sure to include *flats* and *sharps* if necessary.
